FALL REGISTRATIONS will be held after all masses Sept. 27/28 in the large hall for all those families wishing to be part of St. Patrick's Parish and Home Catechism Program. We would like to extend a warm invitation to families with children who are currently enrolled in private or public school and who regularly attend mass together.

The church teaches that the family unit is the domestic church and so accolades must be extended to those families already making this program part of their family life, with the parents participating as their child's first teacher. Learning together, praying together and sharing together strengthens not only the family but also our community of faith.

The children will be invited to bring their Faith First workbook to share with our catechists at the monthly family celebrations on Saturday mornings. First Reconciliation and First Communion

St. Patrick's Parish invites children who have reached the age of reason (7-8 years or older) to prepare for, and celebrate, the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion. Therefore, if you have a child in Grade 2, he/she is eligible to celebrate these sacraments this year.

As the immediate preparation of candidates for these sacraments is the responsibility of parents and of the parish, **parent information meetings will be held at 7 pm on Wed. Sept. 24 and Fri. Sept. 26 in the church.**

Informative letters will be distributed to the children attending our Catholic schools. For those attending public/private schools, please pick up information in the church office.

For families whose children attend one of the schools within St. Justin Martyr's parish boundary, but worship at St. Patrick's Church, the immediate preparation and celebration of the sacraments are the responsibility of St. Patrick's Parish. For families in this situation, there is a letter to be picked up in the church office and parents must attend one of the parent meetings at the end of the month.



Confirmation Preparation

In the sacrament of Confirmation, young people will affirm the faith commitment that their parents made for them at Baptism. Confirmation preparation will soon begin at St. Patrick's. Therefore, if you have a child in Grade 8, he/she is eligible to begin this process. **Parent and candidate meetings will be held at 7 pm on Wed. Nov. 5 and Fri. Nov. 7 in the church.**
